WINE OF ORIGIN Swartland

CELLAR Riebeek Valley Wine Co.

PRODUCTION 4 barrels of 300 litres produced

VARIETAL 100% Petite Sirah

(a cross between Syrah & Peloursin, cross-pollinated in Montpellier by French botanist, François Durif in 1880)

TASTING NOTE

Full-bodied, exquisitely deep colour combined with complex, silky tannins, and succulent bright plum and berry fruit. A wine that speaks of opulence.

VINEYARD

Bush-vine Petite Sirah, planted 2009, in weathered granite soil just outside of Malmesbury.

WINEMAKING

Hand harvested Petite Sirah with 30% whole bunch clusters was cold soaked for 2 days before being wild fermented in open-top stainless-steel tanks; followed by two weeks of extended skin contact. The wine was pressed into 300L older French oak barrels to mature for 8 months prior to bottling.

SERVE & AGEING

Best served at 14 to 18 °C, this wine will develop in complexity over the next 3 - 5 years.
